About UP's Aurora Alliance Mini-grants

International Division of Palacky University Olomouc (UP) is launching Aurora Alliance Mini-Grant Programme to further support the development of the European Universities strategic partnership goals of the Aurora Alliance. This scheme aims to strengthen the cooperation of Palacky University Olomouc with other eight Aurora Alliance university partners **beyond the current project activity scope**.

It primarily offers an opportunity to UP Faculties, Education and Research Centres to engage in academic and professional cooperation across the disciplines within the Aurora Alliance. The scheme supports the bottom-up approach and invites academicians and professional staff to build the working teams with Aurora partners by prioritising their own international academic collaboration ambitions.

The character of the support

Mini-grants will support initial project development and cooperation of small-scale education, research and professionalization projects. They are aimed at supporting the cooperation of the Faculty/Department/Research or Education Institute and Centres at UP with partners of choice at one or several of the Aurora Alliance member universities and the four associate partner universities in Centraleastern Europe. Cooperation should relate to one or more of the Aurora Pilot Domains as well as the Sustainable Development Goals, and demonstrate relevance to Aurora Alliance Mission.

Duration and length

Mini-grants programme aims to have three calls – February 2021, January 2022, January 2023. The first call in February 2021, is aimed as initial support of project start and will allow the successful projects to commence in April 2021. The following two calls will be open to support both continuation of the commenced projects and the new mini- projects each year.

Expected outcomes

UP's Aurora Alliance Mini-Grants scheme will run from 2021 until 2023, offering an opportunity to diverse projects to be developed by UP academicians and supported by varying small-scale grants. The expected outcomes are an increased international academic collaboration further strengthening the Aurora Alliance sustainability. Grants amounts range from 50.000-100.000 CZK.

Procedure and Selection Criteria

Project Application Form found here is to be submitted to Aurora Central Team by 29th March (First Call Opening on 16th of February 2021). Aurora Central Team with a Selection Committee consisting of Vice-Dean for Internationalisation will announce the successfully awarded projects by April 14th 2021.

Selection criteria consist of the following assessment domains:

- <u>Relevance</u> (Aurora Relevance as per Quality of Consortia, Pilot Domains, SDGs, Aurora Mission);
- <u>Significance</u> (Academic/ Professional: disciplinary/institutional/ service-enhancing; incl. projects outputs in the wider community/ challenge-focused);
- <u>Feasibility</u> (Consortia quality incl. team quality, Project implementation plan and roles); and
- <u>Cost-effectiveness</u> (appropriateness of the costs, value for money).
